

Pack 901 Rocker Awards Program

The intent of this program is to recognize the efforts of specific families that put in that "extra hour" a month and do something special to help make our Pack Go. To earn the 3" round Pack badge that these rockers go around, you need to earn at least one of these rockers. Since we do not have great records for past events, we are only awarding rockers for events, training and positions filled since Sept. 1st 2002. The Pack Committee has the final say in awarding any of these badges or rockers.

These badges are to be worn above the right hand pocket.
